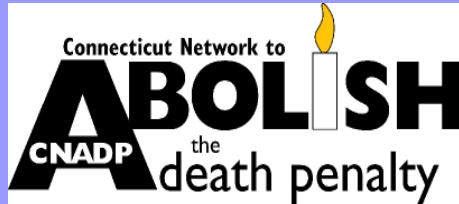


The Connecticut Network to Abolish the Death Penalty
